

Bursary Applications 2026

- The process will be from June to December.
- The respective bursaries open and close on different dates, and applications will be submitted accordingly.
- Feedback will be provided directly by the organisation/company/institution.
- Feedback is also not guaranteed; some bursaries are submitted and only when a candidate is invited for an interview or progresses to the next round will communication be sent out.
- There are no guarantees, but I believe it's worth taking the chance.
- Please note that there are different types of bursaries – ensure that the correct bursary/bursaries are applied for.
- **Academic / Achievement Bursaries** – only for students with an overall average of above 75%. These bursaries are mainly awarded by companies.
- **Need-Based Bursaries** – total household income must be less than R350,000 per year.
- **General Funding** – awarded based on versatility and outstanding performance in various areas (academics, sports, culture, etc.)
- **Sports Bursaries** – applications can be made at all universities. The necessary forms will be distributed. A sports CV is essential.
- **Merit Bursaries** – these are automatically awarded by the respective universities based on final matric results (excluding Life Orientation). No application is needed.
- Specific information regarding student loans will also be shared.
- Unfortunately, bursary opportunities are limited for private institutions.

Required Documents:

1. ID documents (parents and student – newly certified)
2. All school reports received to date (newly certified)
3. Motivational letter (see attached – must be submitted/attached in **WORD FORMAT**)
4. CV (we can compile it on behalf of the student – see form below)
5. Proof of address
6. Proof of income (both parents – payslips are sufficient)
7. Offer from tertiary institution (does not have to be from first choice – any offer is acceptable)
8. Testimonial from school/teacher
9. Bursary application form (see below)
10. Affidavit if parents are unemployed or letter from an accountant or broker if parents own a business
11. Proof of divorce or death certificate (if applicable)
12. Medical certificates (proof of any medical condition/disability)

PLEASE TAKE NOTE:

- All documents **MUST** be submitted neatly and legibly
- Only **PDF documents** will be accepted – no photos of documents
- **NSFAS** opens later in the year and additional documents will be required – see attached form
- Ensure that the email address provided remains accessible – no communication must be missed
